The Level 6 qualifications in Occupational Health and Safety are developed to provide learners who have or are looking to develop into a senior role in an organisation for managing health and safety policy and practice.

About The Program

Course Overview

The Level 6 qualifications in Occupational Health and Safety are developed to provide learners who have or are looking to develop into a senior role in an organization for managing health and safety policy and practice.

Learners will gain the skills and knowledge to understand the legal and regulatory background to occupational health and safety policy, to be able to assess policies, as well as to recommend and implement policy changes. Learners will develop knowledge and skills relevant to putting policy into practice, utilising management systems, resources, risk and incident management, leadership, management and skills development.

Individuals successfully completing the diploma qualification will be eligible to apply for the Graduate level of membership Grad IOSH.





Course Structure

The Level 6 Diploma in Occupational Health and Safety consists of 7 mandatory units for a combined total of 60 credits for the completed qualification.

- Health and Safety Management Principles and Policy
- Health and Safety Management Practice
- Risk and Incident Management
- Promoting a Positive Health and Safety Culture
- Maintaining a Safe Workplace Environment
- Health and Safety Law, Regulation and Influence
- Development of the Health and Safety Practitioner

Entry Requirements

Relevant certificate or diploma or equivalent recognised qualification that covers the following basic concepts within Occupational Health & Safety.

Duration and delivery

The qualification is designed to be delivered over 12 months approximately for part time study.

The qualification is delivered through online meeting platforms, through lectures and tutorials.



Successful completion of Level 6 Occupational Health and Safety qualifications provide learners with the knowledge, understanding and skills to be competent in a range of Occupational Health and Safety roles. Individuals who achieve the diploma qualification will be eligible to apply for Graduate level of membership Grad IOSH.

Those eligible for Graduate membership can then undertake a period of Initial Professional Development which will require students to provide evidence of their practice skills in a skills development portfolio (IPD). At the end of this period there will be a professional review interview. After successful completion of this IPD process students will then be eligible for Chartered membership of IOSH (CMIOSH).



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
